Dräger demonstrates safety in action at Emergency Services Show

Dräger, an international leader in the fields of medical and safety technology, will display fire safety technologies designed to enhance situational awareness and present industry leading solutions to protect firefighter health and wellbeing. All this and more can be seen at this year's Emergency Services Show (ESS).

As a new product launch, Dräger's UCF FireCore® will take centre stage. This hands-free thermal imaging camera is capable of displaying live action imagery into Dräger's FPS 7000 full face mask. The camera gives firefighters continuous vision in the low-visibility, high-risk, and unfamiliar environments that emergencies often present.

With the ability of being fitted to any model, shape or size of helmet, firefighters benefit from the ability to extend their vision in hard-to-reach areas, see around corners, and spot risks before they present further hazard.

Also on show is Dräger's next generation Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA), the PSS® AirBoss, alongside the Long Duration Breathing Apparatus (LDBA) Dräger BG ProAir. Designed to protect firefighters attending deployments, the PSS® Airboss and the Type 4 Nano cylinder offers best in class ergonomics and is the lightest weight breathing apparatus for firefighting. The BG ProAir is specifically designed for longer durations and combines uncompromising safety with the highest level of breathing and carrying comfort.

Last year's headline product, Dräger's FireGround Accountability System, will return for a second time, a system that provides emergency teams with the ability to monitor, communicate and report incidents involving active users of SCBA or LDBA.

FireGround provides a real-time view of all firefighters deployed at an incident, linking firefighters to its system automatically upon opening the cylinder valve of their PSS® AirBoss Connect, relaying vital information back to the Entry Control Board. The Dräger team will demonstrate this in action, with a focus
