Complex tasks demand customized solutions: In the north section of the refinery, Dräger Services supported safety management with an experienced team – from safety guards to gas analysts.

A Rental Shop with repair services was installed to ensure that sufficient amounts of the right safety equipment were available at all times. Over 1,500 ready-to-use devices were available to use, after signing them out, which were later returned for servicing.

During peak times, Dräger Services was on site with a 65 person team. A central project coordinator kept everything running smoothly and ensured effective communication.



Creating a shared safety culture

It is easy to achieve an ambitious long-term goal if you get a motivational push along the way: “Goal Zero” was highlighted once more during Safety Day on November 4, 2015 – with shared activities, training events and practical information.

Truly practical knowledge was acquired, new things were learned from and with one another and unfamiliar things were tried – for example when entering the mobile CSE training system, which provides a realistic simulation of work in confined spaces.

Drastic, but impressive: The “melon demo” on Safety Day shows how important it is to wear a helmet.
