# A lightweight design that's tough enough for any incident

The new HPS SafeGuard fire helmet from Dräger

- **One of the lightest helmets in its class**
- **Excellent weight distribution and a sporty design**
- **A balanced helmet climate even during lengthy incidents**

Lübeck, Germany – The base model of the Dräger HPS SafeGuard weighs just 1.2 kg, making it one of the lightest helmets in its class. In addition to its sporty design, this fire and rescue helmet is designed to have particularly good weight distribution which ensures excellent wearing comfort even when the helmet is worn for a long time. In addition, the great weight distribution means that the helmet will sit securely regardless of the movement of the wearer, for example when crawling or fitting through tight spaces. The helmet is well-insulated to protect its wearer during firefighting, and also ensures a balanced helmet climate at all times, even during long rescue incidents. The adjustable chin and neck strap and an adjusting wheel on the rear of the helmet make it suitable for a wide range of head sizes. The HPS SafeGuard can be adjusted to ensure proper fit to the wearer's head in just a few steps.

### Great protection along with excellent wearing comfort

The HPS SafeGuard has fully integrated visors that provide extra protection for the eyes and face.<sup>1</sup> A multi-layer coating system prevents fogging and scratches. An additional gold coating provides particularly efficient protection against thermal radiation. Reflective strips in different designs can be affixed all around the Dräger HPS SafeGuard, making it easily visible during the day, night, and in poor visibility. The HPS BuddyLight, an optional attachment for the rear of the helmet, provides even more protection and visibility during incidents. Integrated, explosion-protected helmet lamps can be attached and used hands-free on the front or side of the helmet.
