COVID-19 – Technical Training Courses at Dräger Canada

- We will adhere to the Draeger COVID-19 Policy
- Prior to arrival at the Training Course, please take your temperature or self-assess for any symptoms that may be COVID-related. If you have an elevated temperature or are feeling symptomatic you are asked to stay home. If someone in your home is sick with COVID - related symptoms, please stay at home as well.
- Your instructor will meet you at the main entrance where your temperature will be taken, a COVID Screening Questionnaire completed and you will be supplied with a mask (one mask per day).
- Masks must be worn at all times while in the Training Room and in Common Areas (washrooms, lunchroom, etc.,) outside the classroom
- Trainers and students must not shake hands and must avoid close contact (less than 2 metres or 6 feet) where possible
- The Training Room has a maximum capacity of 7 people (Trainer + six students)
- There is a maximum of one person per desk in the Training Room
- Draeger will provide one set of tools per person. The tools will be decontaminated prior to the class.
- Information regarding infection prevention will be posted on the Training Room door
- Prior to the commencement of the class, Draeger will review the COVID-19 policy.
- Trainers and students must regularly wash their hands with soap and water and use hand sanitizer where available.
- To minimize interactions with other Draeger employees, snacks, drinks and meals will be available in the vicinity of the Training Room. Masks may be removed for eating and drinking; physical distancing must be maintained.
- Please use the washrooms nearest to the Training Room. They are regularly cleaned.
