This blended training course enables you to receive Dräger technical training with fewer on-site classroom days – so you spend less time on the road.

SAME QUALITY TRAINING, LESS TIME AWAY

As your Specialist in Critical Care, Dräger knows the importance of certified services for our devices. To make this training easier on your schedule, we are pleased to introduce our first blended training for one of our most in-demand courses: the Evita® Infinity® V500 / Babylog® VN500 training course.

Dräger blended learning combines 24/7 online modules with two days of in-person, instructor-led technical training on-site at our Technical Training Centers in Telford, PA (US) and Mississauga, ON (Canada). You'll receive exactly the same information as with our full on-site courses. The only difference is that much of the material is presented via the Dräger Learning Management System (LMS), which allows you to do the written portion of the class without having to travel. Both course formats cover the exact same subjects at the same level of detail. The only difference is that blended learning is designed to allow for less time in the actual classroom.

CERTIFICATION REQUIRES BOTH ONLINE AND IN-PERSON LEARNING

To become certified for equipment preventive maintenance, you need to attend the full training – including both the online and in-person portions of the training. During the in-person days, you will gain first-hand exposure to the preventive maintenance, troubleshooting, test equipment, and repair topics necessary for the full certificate.

ASSESSMENTS

Two assessments are required to pass the blended learning class – one in the digital modules and the second at the end of the in-person training. Once you have successfully completed the online modules, you are welcome to attend the in-person training as planned. Final confirmation will be determined prior to the class starting date.

You will have three attempts to pass the online assessment, during which you will have access to all online training materials and ServiceConnect®.

To take advantage of V500/VN500 blended training, you'll need a laptop with installed permissions because you will be required to install and configure Dräger's ServiceConnect software – which is used extensively in the online training.

REGISTRATION

The registration process for the V500/VN500 blended learning course is initially the same as for the regular in-person training. However, there are some added steps with the blended program. Dates on the calendar for the in-person classes of the blended program will be published, and you can register for them like any other training using the form provided.

Upon registration, Dräger will send you a confirmation email that provides information about the facility and when and where to arrive on the first in-person training day. Two weeks prior to the start date of the in-person classes, you will receive an email with login instructions on how to access the online modules and how to download and set up Dräger's ServiceConnect portal. You will then have these two weeks to complete the modules and pass the online assessment.
